Programs/Services Offered by the Disability Services Office

- Listed below are just some of the services offered by our Disability Service Office:
 - Additional test time
 - Distraction-free environment for exams (taken in our Academic Resource Center)
 - Electronic textbooks
 - Written instructions for assignments that are not provided in syllabus
 - Permission to record lectures
 - Alternate exam formats (audio, written, electronic)
 - Advance notice for major assignments
 - Consideration for extension of due date or attendance requirements
 - Service animals
 - Preferential seating in the lecture hall
 - Food/water breaks during class
 - Alternatives to in-class discussion
 - Housing accommodations
