Application Process for Students w/ Disabilities

When to apply: After student accepts offer of admission. To enhance the obtainment of aids or accommodations by the start of a semester, the student who believes he or she will need assistance to participate in course work must complete and submit the Application for Services and appropriate documentation to DRES as soon as possible, preferably at least six (6) weeks before the first day of classes. This will allow the applicant and the DRES staff a reasonable period of time in which to determine appropriate accommodations, and to identify the resources in a timely manner.
