# Programs/Services Offered by the Disability Services Office

In addition to accommodations and access, students registered with DRS can engage in weekly academic coaching meetings. These meetings consist of regular interactions with staff members to discuss and establish structure, organization, and accountability of coursework and study skills. Students utilizing this service often experience fewer instances of being overwhelmed by college expectations and are able to get referred to campus and community resources quicker than they might otherwise.
