Application Process for School

Common App/Institutional App: Institutional app/ UW application; easy accessible on our Whitewater page

Deadlines: UW-Whitewater utilizes rolling admission and observed national decision day of May 1st; Scholarship deadline January 1st

Necessary Materials:

- UW-system application
- Application fee or fee waiver
- High school or college transcript
- ACT/SAT scores (Fall 2021 new freshman applicant optional)
- Letters of recommendation not required but strongly encouraged
- No minimum requirements for GPA or test scores
- Minimum requirements of 4 years of English, 3 years of Math, Science and Social Studies

Application Process for Students w/ Disabilities

- 1) Apply and get admitted to UW-Whitewater
- 2) Submit a CSD application (uww.edu/csd)
- 3) Submit documentation (more than an IEP)
- 4) Meet with your Disability Services Coordinator for an intake appointment before your first semester begins
 - Discuss documentation and accommodations
 - Get answers to your questions

Fee Based Services

Adaptive Transportation (Warhawk Wheels): Pick up and drop off service for on and off campus rides.
