

ON YOUR MARQ

SUPPORT FOR STUDENTS ON THE AUTISM SPECTRUM

On Your Marq is a college success program designed to assist Marquette students on the autism spectrum in navigating the college landscape. The program is housed within the Office of Disability Services and addresses needs that are not covered by formal accommodations. Utilizing an interdisciplinary approach, formal and informal supports include weekly seminars, one-on-one coaching, and peer mentors to aid students in developing academic, social, and independent living skills. The first two years focus on each student's transition to the rigors of academia and unique social environment of the college campus. In the second two years, On Your Marq works with each student to identify strengths and skills to transfer to their career and life after college.

The program is provided for a fee of \$3,000 per semester. If this fee would limit participation in the On Your Marq program, please reach out to discuss the funding options available for students with financial need.

AREAS OF SUPPORT

- **Academic:** time management, study skills, academic and career planning, organization, interviewing skills
- **Social:** communication skills, relationship development, social events
- **Independent Living:** self-care, residence hall life, self-advocacy, stress reduction

SUPPORT TEAM

- **Coach:** a graduate student who will meet with the student one-on-one to plan academics, work on independent living skills, and track goals and progress over time
- **Peer Mentor:** an undergraduate student who will meet with the student to learn about life and friendships at Marquette; peer mentors also host monthly social events for the On Your Marq students

Each student's support team will connect them with existing resources on campus that may be helpful, including but not limited to, tutoring, counseling, and residence life.

APPLICATION

Students can apply to On Your Marq after their acceptance to Marquette University. Applications will be reviewed on a rolling basis until program capacity is reached. More details can be found on the On Your Marq website.
