Chapel Haven Application Process

Chapel Haven's ideal candidates are:

- Age 18+
- High school graduates or still completing high school credits through an IEP
- Motivated to begin learning independent living
- Emotionally and behaviorally stable
- Proficient at basic safety skills in an unsupervised setting

- Submit intake review paperwork (recent testing, IEP, transcripts, etc.)
- Complete online application
- Visit campus for a tour
