- Woodcock Johnson Achievement or Wechsler Individual Achievement Test (WIAT) (no more than three years prior to application)
- Current Psychological Evaluation
- Completed Parent Questionnaire
- 2 Letters of Reference
- High School Transcripts/Previous College Transcripts
- Latest IEP (if applicable)
