Type of college: Four-year residential college. Bachelor degrees awarded (BA, BSE, BSS, BMU, and BFA)

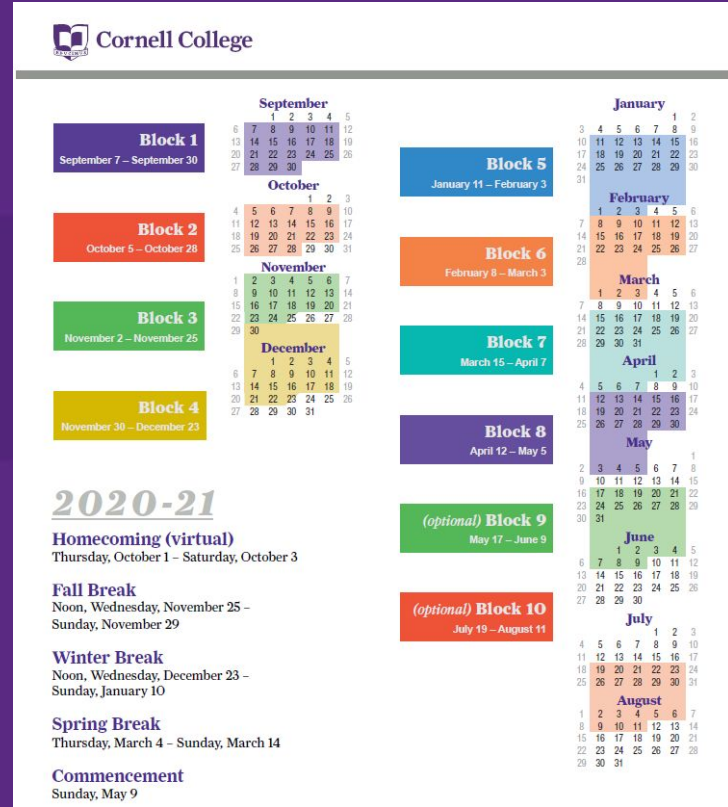
- New programs in engineering, business, musical theatre, behavioral neuroscience

Application Process for Students w/ Disabilities
