- A **copy** of your most recent documentation (see Documentation of Disability below)
- A **copy** of your high school transcript complete through junior year (do not send report cards or other similar documents)
- A **copy** of your senior year scheduled for the whole year, both first and second semester

Project Success is a remedial program for students with dyslexia and other language-based disabilities attending UW Oshkosh. The program was founded in 1979 by Dr. Robert T. Nash and is one of the few university programs in the country that specializes in the use of phonics-based multisensory methodology to improve reading, spelling and writing skills.

Our program currently serves over 300 students who come mainly from Wisconsin and the Midwest, but also from across the US and some foreign countries. **There is no charge for Project Success services, above and beyond the cost of tuition at UWO.**
