Xavier's Application Process

Common App/Institutional App: You can use either the Common App or the Xavier application to apply. Neither has an application fee.

Deadlines: Rolling admission, but a scholarship priority deadline of December 1. Nursing applicants must have complete files by December 1.

Necessary Materials: We are test optional for all majors except nursing as of September 2020. We require one letter of recommendation from either a counselor or teacher.

Step 2: Complete the Online Application Form

Step 3: Schedule an Accommodation Planning Meeting in person or by phone.

Step 4: Meet with Cassandra Jones, Director of Disability Services

Step 5: Request their accommodations each semester

Xavier's X-Path Program

The X-Path Program is a program established to provide individualized support for students on the autism spectrum or with related disorders. Support and coaching is tailored to the needs of each participating student to promote the development of academic competence, social integration, and self-advocacy. The mission of the X-Path Program is to increase opportunities for success for students who have autism and related disorders. Each student will work directly with the Accommodation and Support Coordinator and will also be assigned to a Peer Coach.

Students need to be admitted to Xavier before completing an X-Path application.

There is an additional \$1500 fee per semester for students admitted to X-Path.
